Our Code of Conduct is based on the [Hack Code of Conduct](#), supported by more than 850 individuals and organizations.

We want to provide a safe and pleasant environment and a harassment-free experience for everyone, regardless of someone's

- gender, gender identity and expression
- age
- sexual orientation
- disability
- physical appearance
- nationality
- religion
- political views
- previous hackathon experience (or lack thereof)
- IT expertise
- programming language or tech stack of choice

We do not tolerate harassment of hackathon participants in any form. Sexualized language and

images are not appropriate in any hackathon location, including:

- Hacks
- lectures, presentations, check-ins, workshops, or demos
- any parties associated with the hackathon
- social media
- any other online media

Harassment includes verbal abuse, intimidation, stalking, chasing, photographing or audio/video recording without consent, ongoing interruption of conversations, and unrequested sexual attention.

Hackathon participants who violate these rules will be asked to stop the harassing behavior immediately and can be excluded from the hackathon at the discretion of the hackathon



organizers.

Report to the hackathon organizers at Slack if participants behave inappropriately as outlined Above.
